How-To Guide

Logging into the App

- Upon entering the app, click the Login button
- When prompted, click **Continue** to access the login
- Enter your username and password for IntellicureEHR, and click Sign In



Home Page

- The home page shows the user logged in and clinic
- Quickly access Photos or Problems using the menu bars



Navigation

• Along the bottom of your screen is the **Navigational Menu** - Home, Photos, Patients, and Problems.



- In the top right corner of your screen, locate the menu icon that will appear on all tabs and pages after the home page
- Options include
 - o Home
 - o QR Search
 - Change Databases
 - o Change Default Clinic
 - $\circ \quad \text{Log Out} \quad$
 - The Mobile Companion supports several workflows. From Photos and Problems you have the ability to take a photo, enter measurements, document appearance, treatment orders, and add a new problem.
- The Patients tab is a future feature.

Photos

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 Navigate to Photos by clicking the <u>blue box</u> on the home screen, or Photos found in your navigational menu at the bottom of your screen



Photos – Patient Search

- Here you can see a list of patients you are a clinical participant on, or search for <u>any</u> <u>patient</u> using Last Name, First Name, or Account Number.
- In the top right, turn the filter off to expand the list below.
- The black L box indicates the encounter is currently locked
 - You may have the ability to upload to a <u>locked</u> encounter (setting). You **cannot** add a problem to a <u>locked</u> encounter.

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Photos – Existing Problems

- Locate your patient and open the chart
- The patients name, date of birth, date of service, visit type, place of service, MRN, account number, and site are located at the top.
- Below you see a list of existing problems, click on the Problem to see further details
 - This section is called the Photo List



Photos – Add a Photo

 From the Photo List, click the menu icon in the top right corner to add a photo to that problem





Photos – Retaking a Photo

- Choose the photo that needs retaken, click the menu icon, choose Retake Photo
- After capturing, label the photo, and click Save



Photos – iMeasure.ai

- To measure a wound, click the Problem in which the wound applies to in the Existing Problems List
- Click the menu icon in the top right corner to Take Photo
- Place your <u>gray marker</u> at the top of the wound about **1cm** from the wound edge using the cephalad to caudad or head to toe orientation.
 - This will allow you to consistently capture length and width problem to problem.
 - Make sure the sticker is not inside the wound margins, but right outside
 - Recommendation: lock screen rotation
- Take Photo, then Label the Photo and Save
- Once the photo is saved, **iMeasure.ai** will automatically measure the length and width of the wound.
- Use the green points to adjust the edges, if needed, then click Looks Good
- Select the deepest point of the wound (shown by yellow point), then click Save Depth





- Enter the wound depth and make any adjustments here, then Save
- To add additional measurements, click the menu icon and choose Measurements
 - Pre/Post Debridement
 - Sinus/Tunnels
 - o Undermining

Photos – Charting a Problem

- To chart appearance on the selected wound, click Chart Problem from the menu icon
- Last values will pull forward documentation from previous visits if selected
- Save documentation in each category before moving to the next.

Problems

- Click the Problems tab in the navigational menu and locate your patient
- Click the menu icon in the top right corner to add a new problem
 - Turn common problems on to see your customized list **OR** choose from the dropdown below





- Choose clinical terms that further describe the Problem
- As you choose terms, more will populate to ensure a detailed description
- The detailed description will populate the ICD-10 code
- Enter the Location and Onset, then Save
- · The problem is now added to your existing problems list
